AFFIDAVIT

affirm that:

1. The particulars submitted by me about my son/ward are correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
2. I have read all instructions, terms and conditions, rules and regulations mentioned in the prospectus/ Form and accept to abide by them all.
3. I will have no claim for any amount once paid to the College if I withdraw my son/ward for any reasons.
4. In case of any accident / mishap with my child during his stay at Cadet College Bhurban, I shall have no claim on College management.
5. In case of disciplinary action against my son/ward, the decision of the Principal will be final and I shall have no objection to it and I will not challenge it in any court of law. Also I shall not claim any amount remitted as College dues in case my son/ward is expelled from College for any reason.
6. The College Management shall not be responsible for any harm or injury if my son bunks off/leaves the college without permission.
7. I agree that if my son /ward does not get 70% marks in his send up /pre- board examination his admission to the board will not be sent or will be sent as a private candidate. This clause is relevant to class IX, X, XI and XII.
8. I agree that if my son / ward does not get 60% marks in aggregate in the internal examinations, he will not be promoted to the next class. (For VI to VIII classes only)
9. Security is Refundable; however, No Refund will be made if the student leaves before completion of one year of stay at the College or is expelled on disciplinary grounds at any time.
10. I also agree that my boy will be liable to termination/ fine /or any other punishment deemed fit by college administration if he commits one or more of the following offences:-
 - a. Nonpayment of College dues /funds within the prescribed date.
 - b. Disobedience to senior staff.
 - c. Use of unfair means in the examination.
 - d. Use of abusive language to peers, staff or anyone.
 - e. Committing any act of immorality.
 - f. Leaving the College Premises without permission of the Principal.
 - g. Use or possession of cigarettes or any other narcotics or any lethal weapon including sharp items.
